Invest In Texas Initiative (IITI) Professional Code of Conduct

The IITI professional code of conduct sets the highest professional standard for its members in the conduct and application of the laws, regulations and daily activities relating to foreign investment and the EB-5 immigrant investor regional center program. IITI members recognize that membership is a privilege and that membership brings with it the responsibility to commit to the following:

1. When dealing with prospective agents, investors, lawyers, colleagues, and both the U.S. and foreign governmental agencies and entities, or when processing investment applications of the U.S. EB-5 Immigrant Investor Regional Center Program, members of IITI will conduct daily activities in an ethical manner with integrity, competence and due respect.
2. Members shall avoid conflicts of interests with prospective clients and make any necessary disclosures, as appropriate, relating to any conflict of interest, compensation, consideration, or benefit received from or paid to others where such non-disclosure could compromise the integrity or professionalism of the member.
3. Members shall deal fairly and objectively with any prospective client and preserve the confidentiality of such client's provided records and information as applicable by the law.
4. IITI members shall use reasonable care and exercise sound professional judgment when conducting and engaging in the business of the EB-5 Regional Center program, including but not limited to: i) being familiar with the laws and regulations pertaining to this program; ii) not knowingly making any material misrepresentations and iii) not engaging in any professional conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, or deceit or committing any act that reflects adversely on the Member's professional reputation or integrity.
